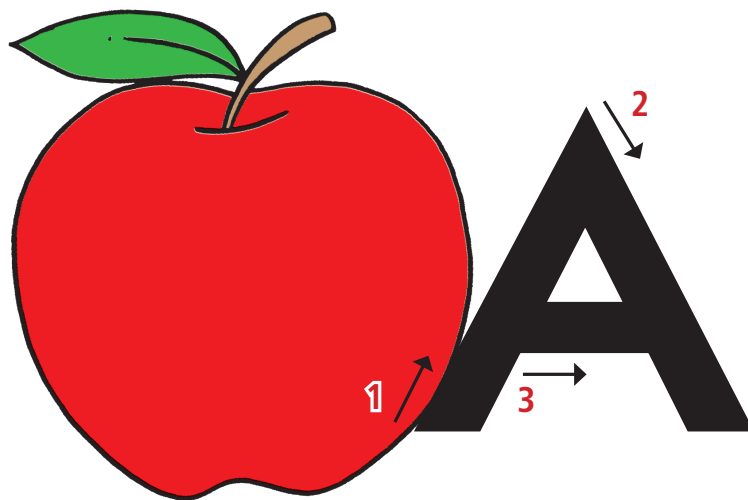

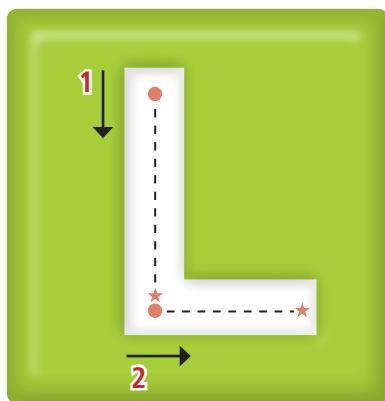
Introduction to the book

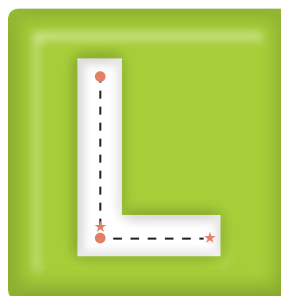
Children love to scribble. Unknowing, scribbling trains the child's hand and fingers. When the child acquires sufficient control over his hands and fingers, he should be encouraged to write letters of the alphabet. It is at this stage, they require appropriate guidance in their attempts to write. Sufficient practice must be given, methodically to help them achieve proper shape, size and bend.

Here the educational concepts are introduced step by step and in a systematic manner, allowing the child to master each skill with minimum strain. Let us get acquainted with the elements used in the book.

Name of the blocks: **Block 5, Block 4, block 3, guider block, challenger block**



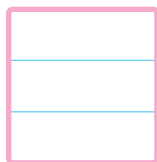

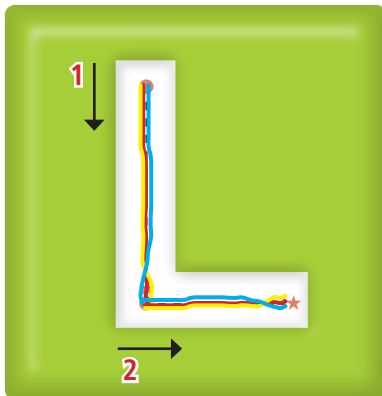

Block 5, is the biggest block where in the child gets his first attempt to convert his scribble into an alphabet. He may or may not get it right. Without any worry, he may repeat his trial



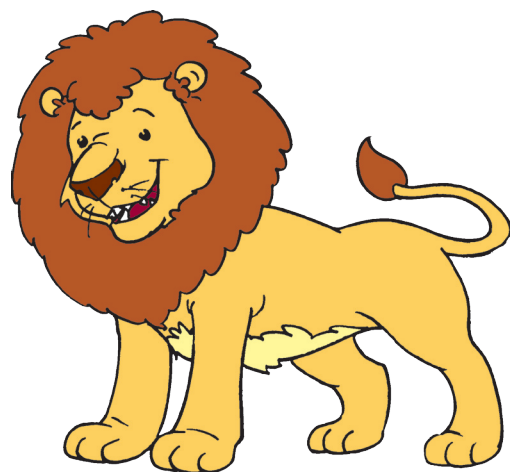
till he gets acquainted in the larger size. Then, he moves on to Block 4 and block 3 to reach the guider blocks. The child then practices over 45 times in the guider blocks till the child reaches the challenger blocks where he uniformly, correctly writes the alphabet, before proceeding to the next. This ensures the child writes the alphabet independently without any reference. In case he fails to get his attempt right, he may again move back to the larger blocks to get his act right and then face the other challenger block.

The Book is designed such that it eases the pressure off the child and simultaneously points out the level at which he faces the difficulty. Once the child is sure of the alphabet and has practiced in various sizes, he can write a clear, controlled alphabet at any size fulfilling our intent.

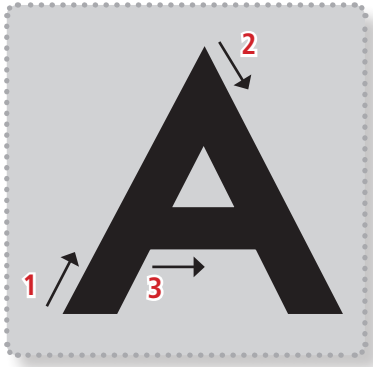
To further add value, there are two more pictures given for the child to get acquainted and an activity to recognise the alphabet covering all the major aspects of Learning, writing and recognising alphabets.
