# HISTORY OF FOOTBALL

According to FIFA, the ancient Chinese ball game, 'Cuju' is the earliest form of football. It seems to be the first competitive game that involved kicking a ball into a net, and was practiced mainly as an exercise according to a military manual from the third and second century BC. It is also believed to have descended from the ancient Greek game of 'harpaston'. 'Harpaston' is mentioned frequently in classical literature, where it is often referred to as a 'very rough and brutal game'. Most modern versions of football are believed to have originated from England in the twelfth century. The game became so popular in England that the kings of that time (Henry II and Henry IV) actually banned football. They believed that football was taking away interest from the traditional sports of England, such as fencing and archery. Modern football has come a long way from its humble origin hundreds of years ago.

A. P. J. Abdul Kalam was born on 15<sup>th</sup> October, 1931. He was the eleventh President of India, presiding from 2002 to 2007. He was a rocket scientist before he was nominated as the President.



He came to be known as the Missile Man of India for his work on the development of ballistic missile and satellite launch vehicle technology. He is widely referred to as the 'People's President.'


After a single term in office, he returned to his civilian life and was involved in education, writing and public service. He was a recipient of several prestigious awards, including the Bharat Ratna, India's highest civilian honour.



While delivering a lecture at the Indian Institute of Management-Shillong, Kalam collapsed and died from a cardiac arrest on 27<sup>th</sup> July, 2015.






