SOUND AND LIGHT WAVES

Sound and light both travel as waves. The properties of these waves differ quite considerably. Sound waves are longitudinal waves consisting of compressions and rarefactions, while light waves are electromagnetic waves consisting of varying electric and magnetic fields. Light travels at a very high speed of 3×10^8 m/s. But sound waves travel much slower at a speed of 332 m/s as their energy dissipates very easily.



Sound waves require a medium and are of different frequencies, giving notes of different pitches. Light waves do not require a medium and are of different frequencies, resulting in different colours.

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

HISTORY OF HOCKEY IN INDIA

The roots of hockey can be traced back to a crude form of the game that was played in Egypt 4,000 years ago and in Ethiopia around 1,000 B.C. The modern game of hockey emerged in England in the mid-eighteenth century, and was introduced in India by the British army regiments. The first hockey club came up in Calcutta in 1885-86, followed by Bombay and Punjab. India made its Olympic debut at the 1928 Amsterdam Games, and the Indian hockey team cruised to its first Olympic gold without conceding a single goal. The golden era of Indian hockey from 1928 to 1956 saw six straight Olympic gold medals, while winning 24 consecutive matches. Some of the legendary and outstanding players of Indian hockey are Dhyan Chand, K.D. Singh, Dhanraj Pillay and Dilip Tirkey. With their exceptional gaming techniques and enduring enthusiasm, India achieved new heights in the field of hockey.





Crunchy veg cheese sandwich


INGREDIENTS:


- 4 bread slices

- A capsicum, tomato, cabbage finely chopped or sliced




DIRECTIONS:

Pre-heat the frying pan over medium flame. Generously butter one side of a slice of bread. Place the buttered side onto the pan and place a slice of cheese and veggies on top of it. Butter the second slice of bread on one side and place the buttered side up on top of the sandwich. Grill until it turns lightly brown in colour and flip over. Continue grilling till the cheese melts. Repeat the same with the remaining two slices of bread. Serve it hot.
