



Animal Records

Largest Animal

The largest known animal on Earth is the blue whale. Blue whales can measure up to 100 feet (30.5 m) from head to tail, and can weigh as much as 150 tons (1,36, 000 kgs). A blue whale's head is so big that about 50 people could fit on it's tongue. Its heart is as big as a car. It is also the loudest animal.



Largest Land Animal

The African elephant is the king among the giants on land. The Indian elephant is much smaller than the African. It would take 165 full-grown men to make up the same weight as the African elephant (7250 kgs). It can reach up to 13 feet tall (3.9 m).



Tallest Animal

The giraffe holds the record. A giraffe may grow 18 feet tall (5.5 m). Height protects giraffes. The long neck lets the giraffe watch from tree top for lions, leopards, hyenas, or wild dogs through the Jungles.



Fastest Animal

The Peregrine Falcon has been reported to reach speeds of up to 200 mph or 322 kmph.



Highest Jumper

The Puma wins the gold medal in the high jump. It can jump up to 15 feet (4.6 m), about 5 times its height.



Fastest Land Animal

The cheetah is the fastest land animal, they can attain speeds of up to 70 mph or 113 kmph.



Oldest Animal

Several tortoises have lived past 120 years, I wonder only if they could speak!



Deadliest Animal

Female Anopheles mosquitoes, which carry malaria, kill more than a million people each year.



Do you know ?

1 meter = 100 cm. That is 1 meter is the length of your 3 long rulers (30 cm) and 10 cm in a straight line. This implies when you similarly put 101 long rulers (30 cm) in a straight line, you get the length of a large blue whale. When you put 18 long rulers vertically top on each other, you get the height of a tall giraffe.


